

The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) have completed our review of the Indianapolis Metropolitan Planning Organization (IMPO) Amendment to the FY 2009-2012 Indianapolis Regional Transportation Improvement Program (IRTIP; see enclosed Resolution No. 10-IMPO-005 dated October 27, 2010). USEPA and IDEM comments support the finding that all applicable Clean Air Act conformity requirements have been addressed.

Therefore, FHWA and FTA find the Indianapolis FY 2009-2012 TIP as amended demonstrates conformity for 8-hour ozone and the annual standard for PM 2.5 as required by the conformity rule.
