Indianapolis Cultural Trail/Georgia Street/Bike Hub



Bring your walking shoes or bicycle to join us for this tour of the award winning Indianapolis Cultural Trail. A Legacy of Gene & Marilyn Glick it is a world-class urban bike and pedestrian path that connects neighborhoods, Cultural Districts and entertainment amenities, and serves as the downtown hub for the entire central Indiana greenway system. The new Indy Bike Hub YMCA at downtown's City Market will also be part of the tour.

Also included will be the Georgia Street Improvement project. In preparation for Super Bowl 2012 this project will establish a very pedestrian friendly convention and community events venue, while enhancing the character and functionality of downtown's Wholesale District. By creating additional space for tourism and entertainment, the viability of the downtown will be strengthened.

Airport Vicinity / Logistics Tour

Find out how transportation connectivity and appropriate land use planning have helped spur economic development in the vicinity of the Indianapolis International Airport. Learn about the history of planning and zoning for the areas surrounding the airport; how the Federal Express hub is attracting business growth; and how recently completed and future highway construction plans in the area have helped facilitate growth at the airport, the Federal Express hub and at the major manufacturing and distribution facilities in the area. A bus will be used for touring the area with stops at several of the major facilities.
