The status of air quality standards with regard to the National Ambient Air Quality Standards for nine counties in Central Indiana: Boone, Hamilton, Hancock, Hendricks, Johnson, Madison, Marion, Morgan, and Shelby.

Ozone

With regard to the 8-Hour Ozone Standard the nine-county region is designated as **Attainment Maintenance Area** as per the October 19, 2007 Federal Register of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.

Particulate Matter

With regard to the fine particulate matter (PM 2.5) four of the nine counties (Boone, Hancock, Madison, Shelby) are designated **Attainment** and the other five (Hamilton, Hendricks, Johnson, Marion, Morgan,) are designated **Nonattainment** for PM 2.5.
